The Archive of Scientific Philosophy at Hillman Library, University of Pittsburgh, is a center for research in the history of scientific philosophy, logical empiricism and early analytic philosophy. Its holdings include the scholarly papers of Rudolf Carnap, Hans Reichenbach, Frank Plumpton Ramsey, Paul Hertz, Rose Rand, and others, in addition to copies of related manuscripts and documents from other facilities.

*Full Circle* is a new series that presents the Publications of the Archive of Scientific Philosophy. Under the general editorship of Steve Awodey (Carnegie Mellon University), it publishes original, hitherto unpublished documentary material from the Archive of Scientific Philosophy and related collections around the world, as well as monographs and collections of essays on subjects related to papers contained in these archives, spanning the entire history of philosophy, science, and scientific philosophy in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.
